



FWMUN Youth Ambassador for the SDGs and the 2030 Agenda 2018 Resolution

1. Emphasizes on the importance of adopting the global goals as an identity, and to direct all energy towards attaining them;

 - c) Reducing waste generation through recycling;
8. Further invites public citizens to join global campaigns;
9. Welcomes the involvement of local governments and representatives in the global goals and emphasizes on the importance of having a combined effort between both public citizens and local governments to accomplish the global goals;

10. Further reminds of the fact that no development is sustainable without culture and thus calls upon members of the international community to be open minded, embrace the differences and empower others;

11. Supports the building and development of safe and sustainable communities through implementing strategies such as carpooling and bike;

12. Draws attention to the importance on focusing on the needs of undernourished groups and committing to meeting their needs in the most efficient way possible.
